Set Apart for the Journey: Learning to Walk with God Together

Beginning this season, we invite you to join us for a meaningful journey through Scripture as we move toward Easter together. This series builds on our recent focus, "Crossing the Threshold: Taking the Next Faithful Step," and asks a deeper question: How do we live once we've stepped out in faith?

Healing relationships for clear discernment.


Memory Verses: Join Pastor Brian and Lucille in memorizing a passage from the Bible every week in 2025 and 2026.


They can all be left in the foyer

As Lent begins and African Heritage Month continues, pray for the next generation, especially within Black communities. Ask God to provide opportunities for growth, education, and leadership. Pray for young people discerning God's call, that they would respond with faith, joy, and obedience.

Canadian Baptist Ministries (CBM)

Europe: Pray that the Holy Spirit will personally guide the growth of 2 new believers – rooting them deeply in God's Word and shaping them into joyful, life-giving disciples of Christ

God's Spirit is gently softening the hearts of several long term seekers as they pray and participate – only one final step of commitment remains. Pray that God will grant them courage and faith to respond to His love.

Latin America and Caribbean: Pray for the Latin America team so that in this first quarter they have meetings that will allow them to clearly define how we will walk with our partners in 2026.

MENA: For grace to prevail over pressure, and for the 2026 projects to be carried to completion even as the region faces uncertainty, unrest, and heavy challenges.

For Sudan, as the world looks away and the suffering deepens—may the Lord intervene, bring peace, protect the innocent, and turn mourning into hope.

North America: Central Canada – Pray for protection and warmth for those without shelter during these cold winter days in Central Canada. Pray for strength and wisdom for churches serving them, and for Christ's love to bring dignity and hope.

Africa: Pray that the church in Rwanda and around the world would become a catalyst of peace

through the believers who follow Jesus, the prince of peace.

Asia: Kazakhstan – Almaty Bible Institute (ABI), Kazakhstan, is celebrating 35 years of teaching ministry this year. Pray that the Lord would lead them to equip ministers for the ministry in multi-faith and multi-cultural contexts. Also pray for the doctoral colloquium in February for teachers; Christian Leadership program and music ministers and LEPTA project – theologising in local context for local churches.
